Black Turtle Bean Soup

- 1 pound black turtle beans
- 1 pound ham
- 4 teaspoons olive oil
- 2 large yellow onions, chopped
- 3 quarts water
- 1 teaspoon ground pepper
- a pinch of cayenne or red pepper flakes
- 4 teaspoons ground cumin
- 2 teaspoons oregano
- 3 bay leaves
- 4 cloves garlic minced
- 2 teaspoons grated orange peel
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 red bell pepper, chopped
- 3 tablespoons fresh chopped parsley
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar

Cook onions in oil. Wash beans and cook ham, onions and beans in water.
Cook the beans, ham and onions on medium heat until the beans are soft but not mushy (4-6 hours).
Remove half the bean mixture and mash it well, until it forms a "bean paste."
Add bean paste back into soup. Add herbs and cook about 1 hour.
Meanwhile, cook orange peel, garlic, red pepper, lemon juice, and brown sugar.
Add to beans. Heat thoroughly and serve with sour cream and salsa on the side.
